Colonel Terrence L. Koudelka, Jr. is the Director of Staff, Headquarters Pennsylvania Air National Guard. He serves as the principal advisor to the Deputy Adjutant General-Air regarding federal and domestic operations programs and policies affecting the 4100 assigned personnel serving in three wings and six separate locations in the Commonwealth.

Colonel Koudelka graduated from The Ohio State University with Bachelor of Science Degree and was commissioned as a second lieutenant in 1990 through AFROTC Det 645. He completed Specialized Undergraduate Navigator Training at both Randolph AFB, TX and NAS Pensacola, FL. He served nearly 11 years on active duty in both staff and flying assignments as a B-1B Weapon Systems Officer (WSO).

Colonel Koudelka's career includes participation in numerous combat operations while flying as aircrew in the B-1B, EC-130E and EC-130J. In addition, his ground combat experience includes several tours with US Army maneuver units as a jump qualified Air Liaison Officer/Joint Terminal Attack Controller at the battalion, brigade, division and corps level.
