You will NOT have an opportunity to purchase items at our school, so buy them prior. **Place a check mark next to each item on the checklist below as you prepare for school.** Designate the number of items you have packed. **You must bring this checklist with you to sign-in.** Please attempt to procure all items to within your financial ability. PENNSYLVANIA WING CADET TRAINING SCHOOLS – CONTRABAND LIST

The following items are not permitted at our schools. Each student's gear will be checked upon sign-in for any of the following contraband items. Units are strongly encouraged to conduct a gear check prior to sending their members to our schools. Any student found to have arrived at school with any of these items will have their parents and Unit Commander notified.

The following contraband items, if found, is grounds for immediate dismissal from the school and possible police involvement:

1. Illegal Drugs (immediate dismissal and police involvement)
2. Firearms or other weapons; defined by the State of Pennsylvania (immediate dismissal and police involvement)
3. Lighters, matches or any fire starting devices
4. Tobacco products of any type
5. Knives, any type or size

The following contraband items must be taken home by a parent/guardian or a pre-designated CAP member who transported the student to school. Students will not be permitted to sign-into the school while any of these are within their possession when they arrive:

1. Digital and/or electronic devices including but not limited to: Tablet computers, MP3 players, personal electronic fitness devices (e.g. Fitbit), CD/DVD/Blu-ray players, alarm clocks, video game consoles, audio speakers, etc.
2. Food items such as snacks, candy, etc.
**Exception for emergency sugar source as needed by diabetic students. Please notify this on the medical comments section of your signature packet or send us an email prior to the school: schoolapps@pawgcts.org
3. Energy drinks (Red Bull, Monster, 5-hour Energy, NOS, etc)
4. Cell Phones or other wireless communication devices (including pagers, beepers, walkie talkies, etc)
5. Vehicle keys (cadets who must drive themselves to and from the school must surrender their car keys to the administration staff during sign-in. They will be given their keys back after graduation).
6. Aerosol spray cans including but not limited to: Hairspray, bug repellent, sunscreen, deodorant, etc
7. Time telling devices (e.g. watches) for Encampment Students only (LDC students are permitted this item)
